

# Developing a Biblical World View

The motivation for suggesting this topic is that I think we as a community spend too much time on word studies and such and don't always have a strong grounding in a truly biblical world view--which acts as a compass for living in an increasingly post-biblical society.

The class will cover five topics:

1. God (theism)
2. Creation (viewing the world as Creation, not merely nature; this would include some material on the environment, including the shmita or land sabbath from the Law of Moses)
3. Love (loving God, loving neighbour, charity, etc.)
4. Justice (social justice, equity, etc. from the Law to the teachings of Christ)
5. Peace (this gets us into our principles of non-resistance, C.O. status, but also our belief in peace to come)

Each topic has a section on how the principle is related to or exemplified by Christ.
