

**GREAT LAKES CHRISTADELPHIAN BIBLE SCHOOL
BY-LAWS**

**ARTICLE I
PURPOSES**

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation (hereinafter called GLCBS) is organized are:

To instruct, disseminate, publish and otherwise teach Christian doctrine and more especially the religious doctrines of the revealed word of God which the Christadelphians believe and uphold, as set forth in the "Christadelphian Birmingham Unamended Statement of Faith." Fellowship is extended to all persons who are baptized and accept the principles of the doctrines contained therein.

To organize and conduct schools, meetings, worship services and other assemblies which may be deemed necessary or appropriate to achieve the foregoing purposes.

To comply in all respects with the requirements set forth under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, more specifically enumerated as follows:

The specific purposes of this corporation are religious as described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. No part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual and it shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation.

Distributions of funds shall be made only to organizations also exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Upon dissolution of GLCBS, any remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

GLCBS also has such powers as are now or may hereafter be granted by the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of the State of Illinois.
